

Honda at ProLogis Swindon



The Requirement

Honda Logistics UK wanted to relocate to a new purpose-built facility and needed to move swiftly to take advantage of a break in the lease on its existing headquarters building in Swindon and to be ready for the New Year sales rush.

The Solution

ProLogis secured a site next to Honda's manufacturing plant, five miles from Junction 15 of the M4. The team then worked closely with Honda to develop a new HQ and distribution centre for car parts, motorbikes and power equipment that was designed to enhance both the office and warehouse functions and to make Honda's operations more efficient.

Architects Michael Sparks Associates designed a 350,000 sq ft distribution centre with 21,000 sq ft of offices and following a 10 month build programme, Honda Logistics was able to move into its new headquarters in time to meet the January sales peak.
